


IN THE BOX






1. ASSEMBLE



Secure the upper handle (A) to the mid handles (B) with two fix bolts. Secure the mid handle to lower handle (C) with four fix bolts.




Position the complete assembled handle over the studs of both sides on the rear of mower frame.




Place the grass box onto two hooks on machine.

2. PREPARE



Cutting height has been set in the 30mm position when packed. If need adjust the cutting height, loose wing nut (A) which located on both sides of the mower. Move roller brackets (B) to the desired height of cut. Tighten the wing nut.

3. OPERATE



- i. Do not cut wet grass because it tends to stick to the underbody of the product, preventing the proper discharge of grass clippings, and it could also cause you to slip and fall.
- ii. Never cut off more than one-third of the total length of the grass for a healthy lawn. In the autumn, lawns should only be cut as long as there is growth.
- iii. Slowly push the product forward.
- iv. Mow in slight overlapping rows. The most effective pattern for mowing lawns is straight lines along one of the sides. This will keep the rows even and ensures that all the lawn is cut without missing any spots.
- v. Circle around flower beds. When reaching a flower bed in the middle of the lawn, cut a row or two around the circumference of the bed.
- vi. Pay special attention when changing direction.
